Then glue it onto the paper bag body directly under the puppet face. Be sure to flip the bottom up so that you can fit the paper onto the bag.

Measure the top flap of the paper bag and cut out a piece of black card stock that size. Ours measured 5"x3". Glue onto the top flap. Measure the bottom part of the paper bag and cut out another rectangle that size. Ours was 5"x9". Glue in place. Glue the white face in the middle of the top flap.
